

Installing Bootloader version B7.06 if you have Bootloader version B7.02

Summary

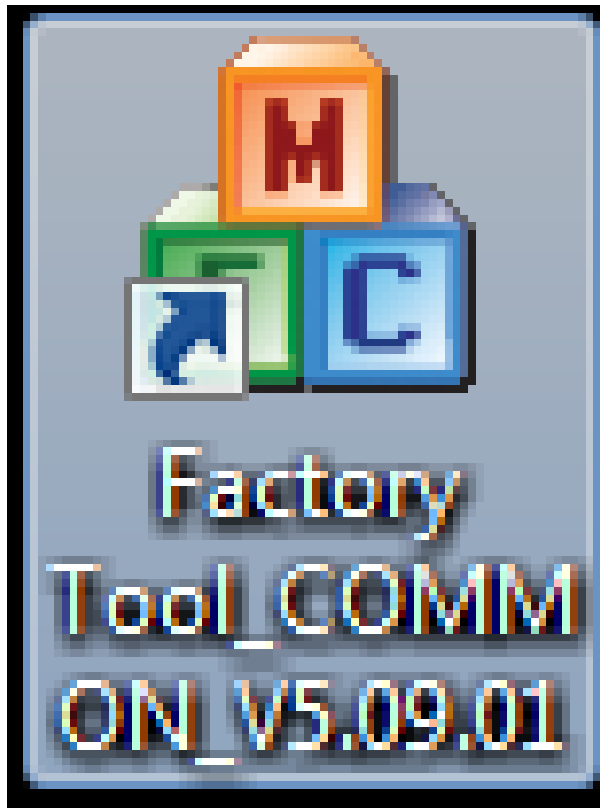
This document provides step-by-step instructions for upgrading the bootloader of a radio from version B7.02 to B7.06. The process involves connecting the radio to a computer using a programming cable, pressing specific buttons on the radio, and using the Factory Tool_COMMON_V5.09.01 software.

Detailed Instructions

Connect the radio to the computer with the programming cable. Press the PTT and Top Orange button on the radio at the same time and then turn on the radio. You should see the following screen on the radio:



If you do not already have Factory Too Common Version V5.09.01 install it and you should get the following shortcut as shown below.

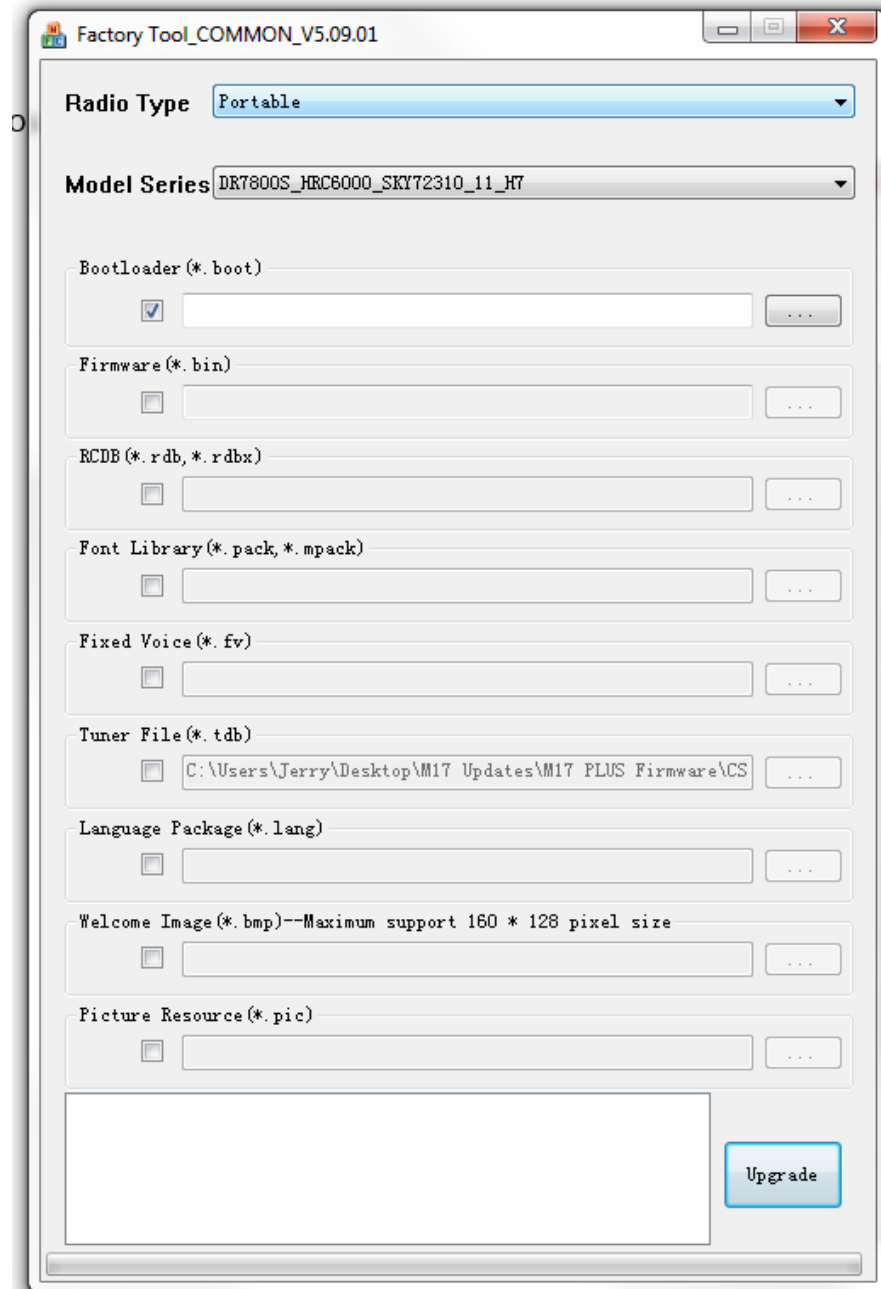


Start the program by double clicking on the shortcut as shown above.

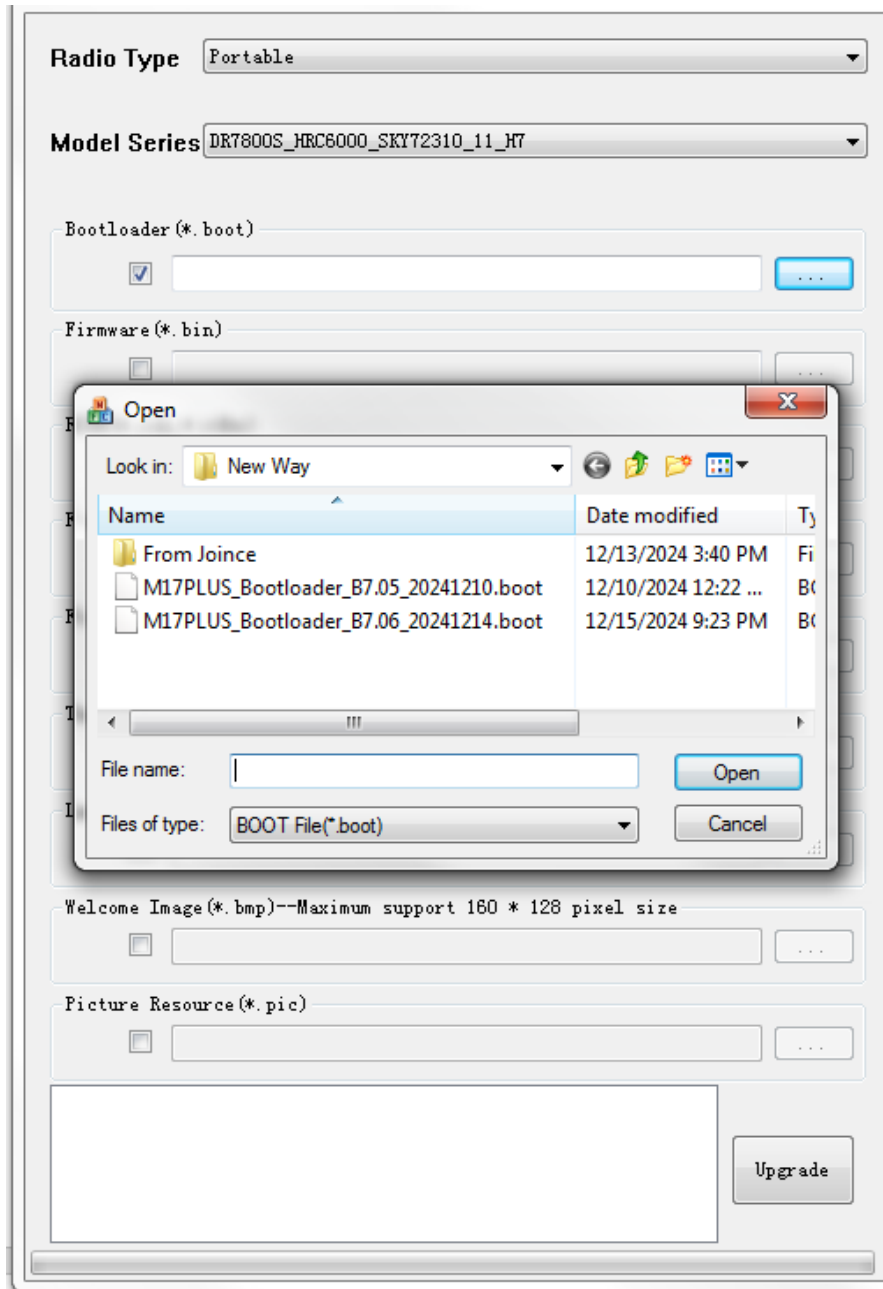
You should then get the following screen:



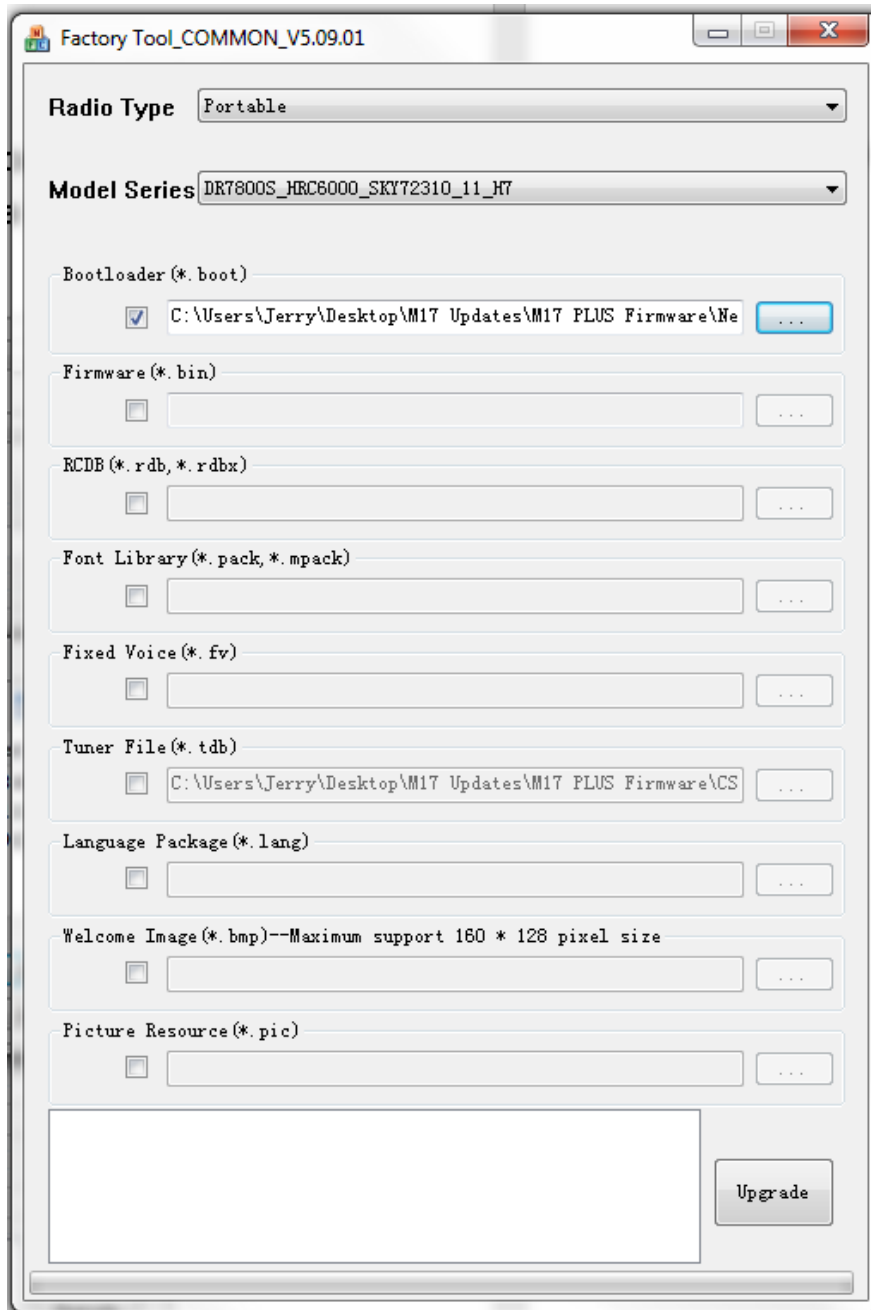
Set the Model Series and bootloader check box as shown below:



Click on the button to the right of the “bootloader (*.boot)” that has three dots on it and you should get a box like below to find the bootloader you want to use.

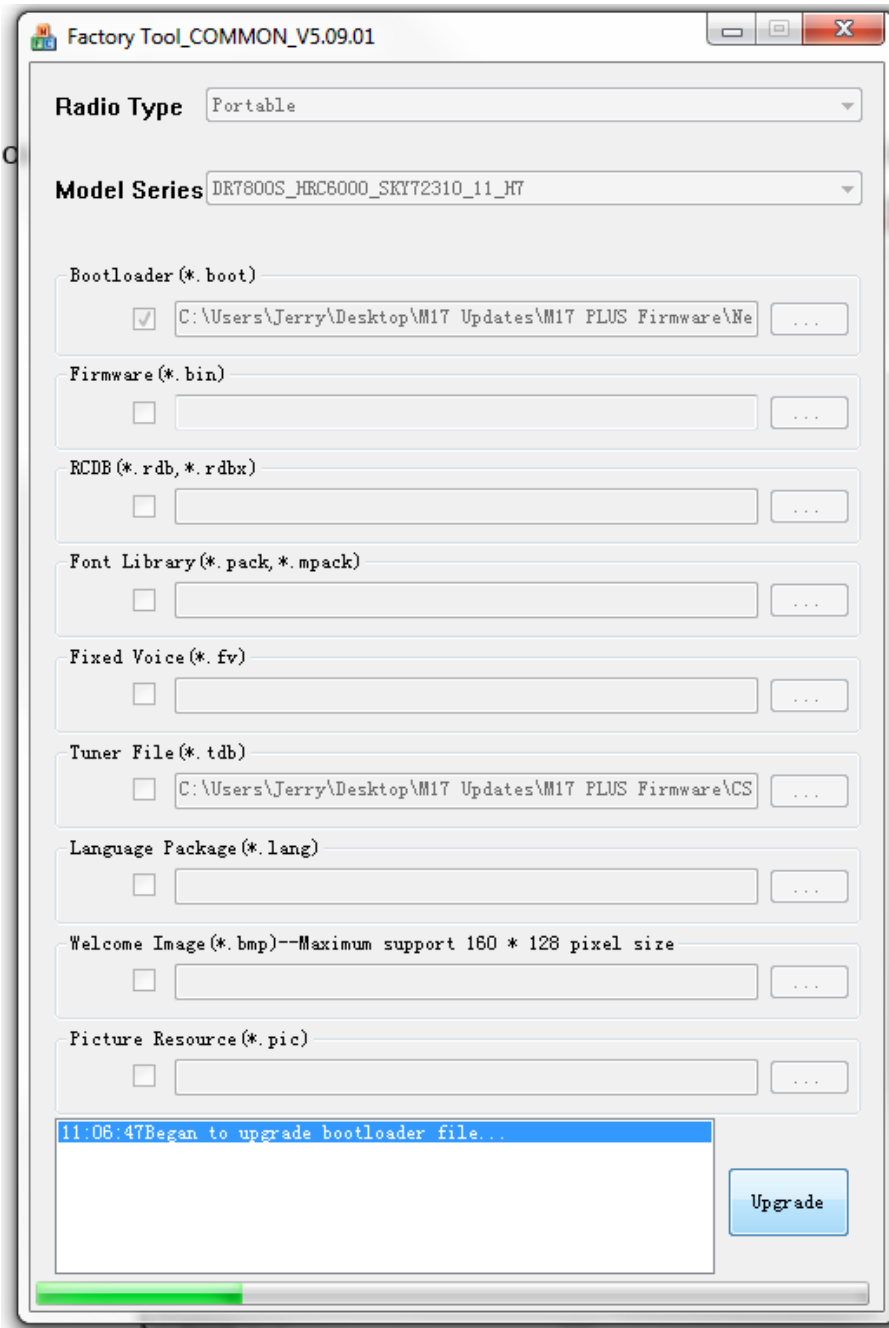


Double click on the appropriate file and you should get the following:

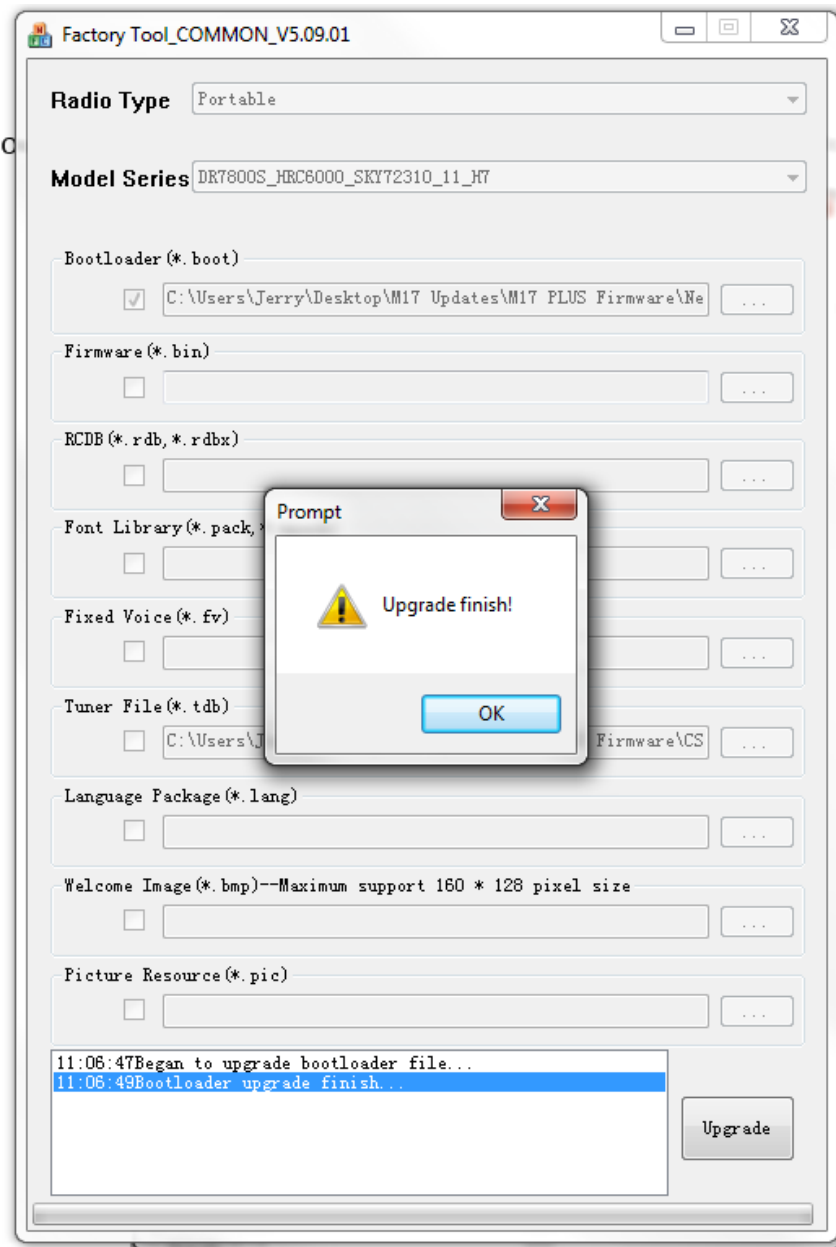


Notice the bootloader rectangle now has the location of the bootloader. Press the “Upgrade” button and you are done with pressing keys.

If all things are going right, you should see the screen below



And in a few seconds, you should see the following screen:



You are now finished. Press the OK button above and exit from that program. Check the radio to see the correct bootloader is installed and if not try again.
